To be held on the ocean front Ernie Els designed championship course, the location offers spectacular views across the turquoise waters of the serene lagoon, while each hole intricately weaves around the coastline to create technical challenges to players of all levels.

Guests attending the week long competition can enjoy luxury accommodation in a Garden Pool Villa at Four Seasons Resort Mauritius at Anahita, each of which features extensive outdoor terraces, a private plunge pool and secluded tropical gardens.
